COMMUNITY RELATIONS

VISITS TO THE SCHOOL

The Salem Board of Education and staff of Salem School welcome and strongly encourage members of the community and other interested persons to visit the school.

The Superintendent shall establish procedures which:

1. Encourage school visitations.
2. Provide for appropriate hospitality for visitors.
3. Channel expressions of approval and constructive criticism to the Board of Education.
4. Ensure that public visits will not hinder the educational program.
5. Protect the safety of students and staff.

Loitering or Causing Disturbance

Loitering is not permitted on school grounds. Any person shall be considered loitering on school grounds when he/she remains in or about the school building or grounds without administrative approval or a relationship to or responsibility for a student.
