ADMINISTRATION – BASIC CONCEPT

The Superintendent of Schools is responsible, within the guidelines established by Board of Education policy, State and Federal laws and regulations, and employee agreements, for directing and coordinating the staff to achieve the goals and general objectives adopted by the Board of Education consistent with the District's educational philosophy.

The Board of Education expects the Superintendent, and other Administrators, to understand and practice effectively and efficiently:

1. Decision-making and communicating;
2. Planning, organizing, implementing, and evaluating programs and personnel;
3. Coordinating between the School District and community to work cooperatively on behalf of local education.

The Superintendent of Schools is encouraged to conduct the operations of the School District according to the management team concept.
