FOOD SERVICE: PURPOSES AND FACILITIES

The school lunch program shall be an integral part of the total educational program. An attractive, wholesome, well-balanced lunch is essential for the best work from the students.

To accomplish this objective with appropriate economy, all administration of the food services program will be coordinated in the office of the Superintendent or his/her designee.

The educational aspects of the school lunch program will be the responsibility of the school Principal, subject to advice, counsel and direction from the Superintendent of school.
